Things to include in your work: Short Bio of the composer (dates, early life, music education, adult life, love interests, etc.) Information about the piece: When it was composed. First performance? What is the instrumentation, structure? What is it about/what inspired it? If it is a vocal piece, provide the text and translation if in another language What makes this piece difficult? Has it been transcribed for other instruments? Has it been used in any famous movies/tv shows?

Why is it so significant? What are your thoughts on the piece?

Include a link to a performance (recorded or live). Preferably, embed a Youtube video of the piece in your presentation. Include your sources!
